



Drug Policy

Purpose:

Woori Yallock Football and Netball Club is committed to promoting a safe, healthy, and drug-free environment for all players, officials, volunteers, and supporters. This policy aims to outline the Club's stance on drug use and provide guidelines for appropriate conduct.

Policy Statement:

Prohibition of Illegal Drugs:

The use, possession, distribution, or sale of illegal drugs, including but not limited to substances listed under Australian law as prohibited or restricted, is strictly prohibited on Club premises, during Club events, or while representing the Club.

Prescription Medications:

Members using prescription medications must ensure they are taken as prescribed and do not impact their ability to participate safely in Club activities.

Testing and Consequences:

Testing:

The Club reserves the right to conduct drug testing on players and officials where reasonable suspicion of drug use exists, in accordance with legal and privacy guidelines.

Consequences:

Any player or official found using, possessing, distributing, or selling illegal drugs on Club premises or during Club activities will face disciplinary action. Consequences may include suspension, fines, or expulsion from the Club, depending on the severity of the offense.

Reporting to Police:

The Club may report individuals involved in illegal drug activities to the relevant authorities, including the police, where warranted by law.

Education and Support:

Education:

The Club will provide education and information on the risks associated with drug use, including the impact on health, performance, and legal consequences.
